

RING SIZE GUIDE MEASURING ONE OF YOUR RINGS

PLEASE PRINT THIS PAGE, MAKING SURE THAT YOU SELECT "NO SCALING" UNDER THE "SCALE TO PAGE" OPTION OF YOUR PRINT MENU. TO VERIFY THE PAGE HAS PRINTED CORRECTLY, USE A RULER TO MEASURE THE SCALE JUST UNDERNEATH; IT SHOULD MEASURE 1 CM.

- 1. Select one of your rings that you usually wear on the finger on which you intend to wear your new ring.
- 2. Place this ring on the circles below in order to determine the right size.
- 3. The selected circle should correspond exactly with the diameter of your ring. Make sure the outline of the circle is visible within the diameter of your ring.
- 4. If your ring is between two sizes, select the larger size.





RING SIZE GUIDE MEASURING YOUR FINGER

- 1. Grasp a length of string or cut a strip of paper.
- 2. Wrap it around the largest part of your finger.
- 3. Use a pen to mark the point where it forms a circle.
- 4. Using a ruler, measure the distance from the end of the string or paper to the mark you made.
- 5. Compare your measurement with the chart below to determine your ring size. If you are hesitating between two sizes, choose the larger one.

BRACELET SIZE GUIDE MEASURING YOUR BRACELET

- 1. Select a bracelet of yours that fits you well.
- 2. Lay it flat.
- 3. Using a ruler, measure the distance between the top of the clasp and the furthest edge of the bracelet.
- 4. Choose a CHANEL bracelet size that is as close to this measurement as possible.

MEASURING YOUR WRIST

- Grasp a length of string or cut a strip of paper. Wrap it around the wrist on which you would like to wear your □CHANEL bracelet.
- 2. Use a pen to mark the point where it forms a circle.
- 3. Using a ruler, measure the distance from the end of the string or paper to the mark you made.
- 4. Add 1.5 cm to the measurement, so that the size of the bracelet is comfortable enough for you. You can then add or remove centimetres if you prefer wearing it tightly or loosely.
