## RESPONSIBLE JEWELLERY STATEMENT 2024

Chanel Watches & Fine Jewellery creates watches, precious jewellery and high jewellery using raw materials such as gold and other precious metals, diamonds, pearls and other gemstones.

Chanel is a member of the Responsible Jewellery Council (RJC) and has been certified by RJC since 2011. The RJC is the primary standard setting organisation for the jewellery and watches industry, working with more than 1,600 members globally to advance sustainable supply chains and responsible business practices. The RJC Code of Practices is the only industry standard covering the entire jewellery and watch supply chain. In support of Chanel's sustainability ambition, Chanel has renewed its RJC certification in 2024 under the 2019 Code of Practices.
